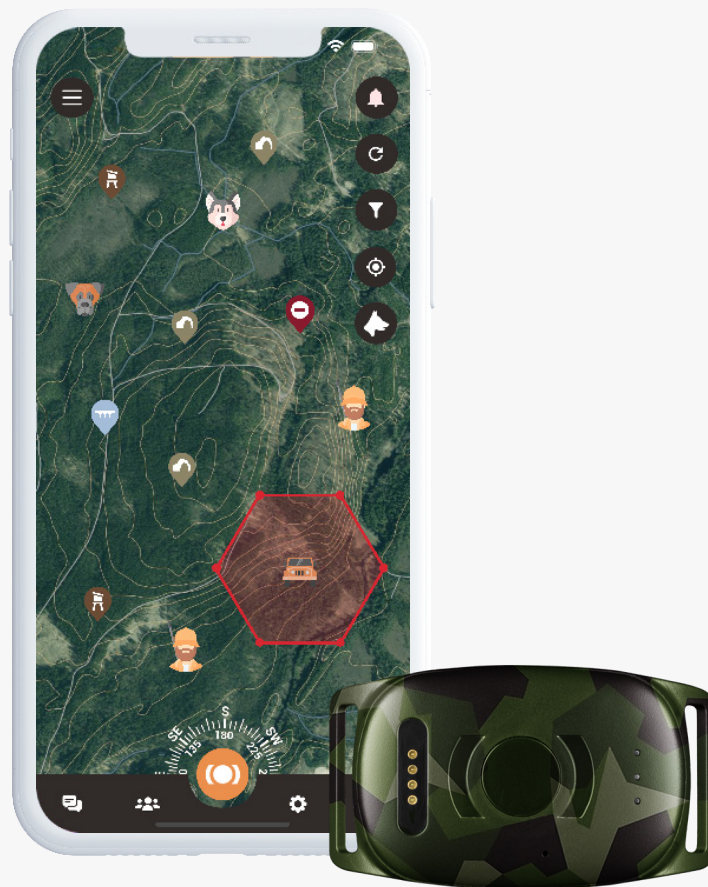

Before you start using your Vexo, please read this user manual in its entirety.



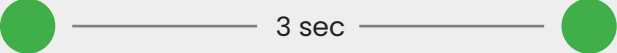

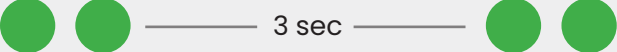

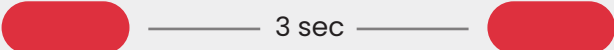
Explanation of LED

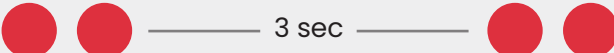
GREEN LED:

 Blinks once = Searching for mobile network

 Blinks twice = Connected to mobile network

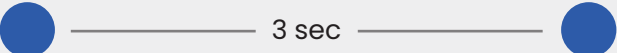
RED LED:

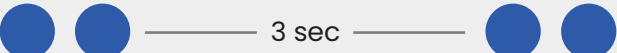
 Blinks slowly = Charging in progress

 Blinks twice = Connected to Bluetooth

 Steady light = Fully charged

BLUE LED:

 Blinks once = Searching for GPS signal

 Blinks twice = GPS signal acquired

*Press the Power button once when the device is on to get an indication of the approximate battery life.
5 blinks = Approximately 100%, 4 blinks = Approximately 80%, down to 1 blink = Approximately 20%.*

Download MiniFinder Hunter

Get started by downloading MiniFinder Hunter from the Apple App Store or Google Play. Simply search for 'MiniFinder Hunter' and join the MiniFinder family alongside hunters from all over the world, completely free of charge.

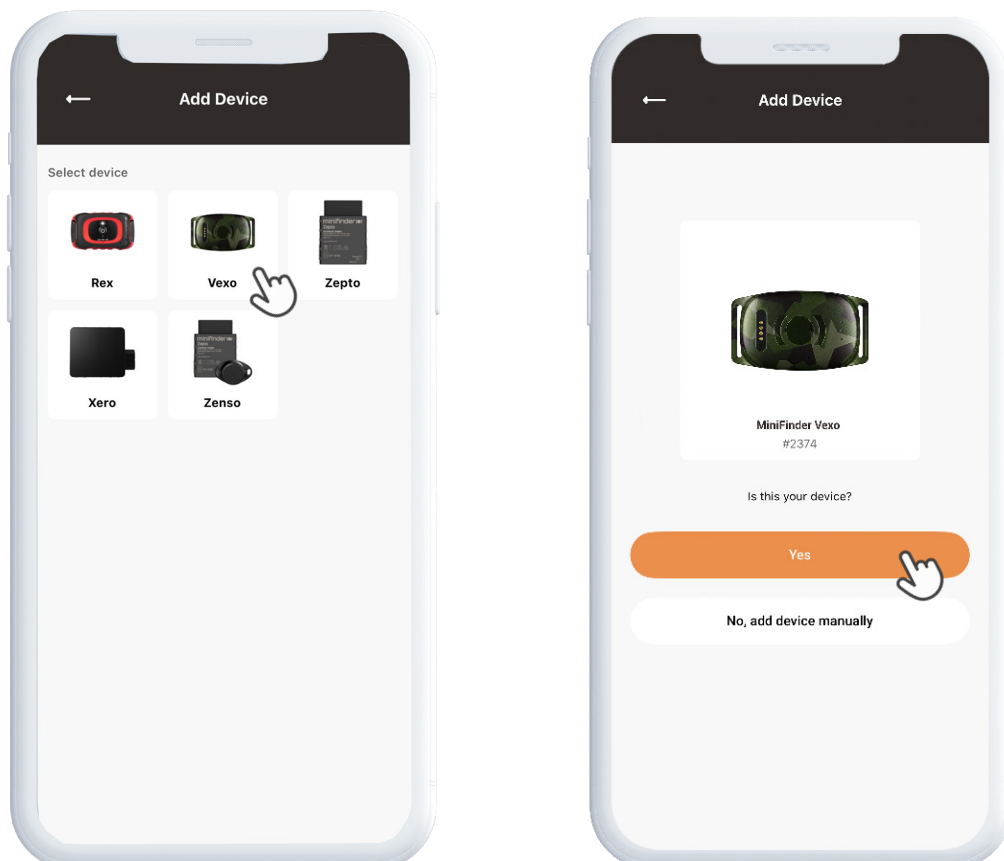


Add a new device

This applies only to new devices. To access a device that someone else has, see the instructions on how to Share location.

To add a new device to your account, start your MiniFinder and connect it to a charger. Make sure Bluetooth is turned on in your mobile phone and that you are close to your MiniFinder during the registration process. Go to the menu and select Devices. From there, tap Add new device and choose the device model you want to add.

The app will now search for nearby devices and you will be given a suggested device. Check that the last four digits shown on the screen (#XXXX) match the last four digits of the IMEI number on the back of your MiniFinder. If the numbers match, tap Yes. If not, choose to add the device manually. You can do this by entering the IMEI code yourself or by scanning the barcode on the packaging. Finally, choose a name for your MiniFinder and tap Add device.

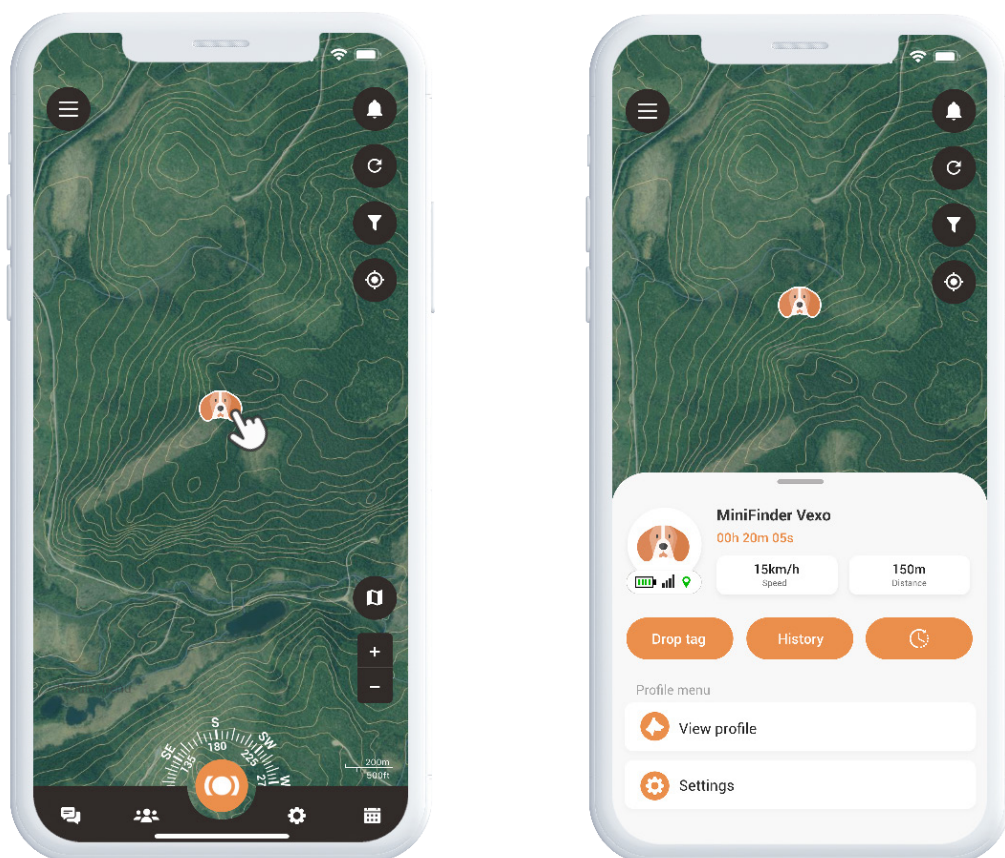


Device Panel

The Device Panel gives you a quick overview of your dog and access to several of the device's key features. To open the panel, tap your dog's profile on the map.

Here you can view your dog's speed, distance and BPM (barks per minute). Swipe the panel upwards to access additional options, including update interval, call, vibration, LED light, sound signal and Find Me. The Find Me feature uses Bluetooth to help you locate the device when you are nearby.

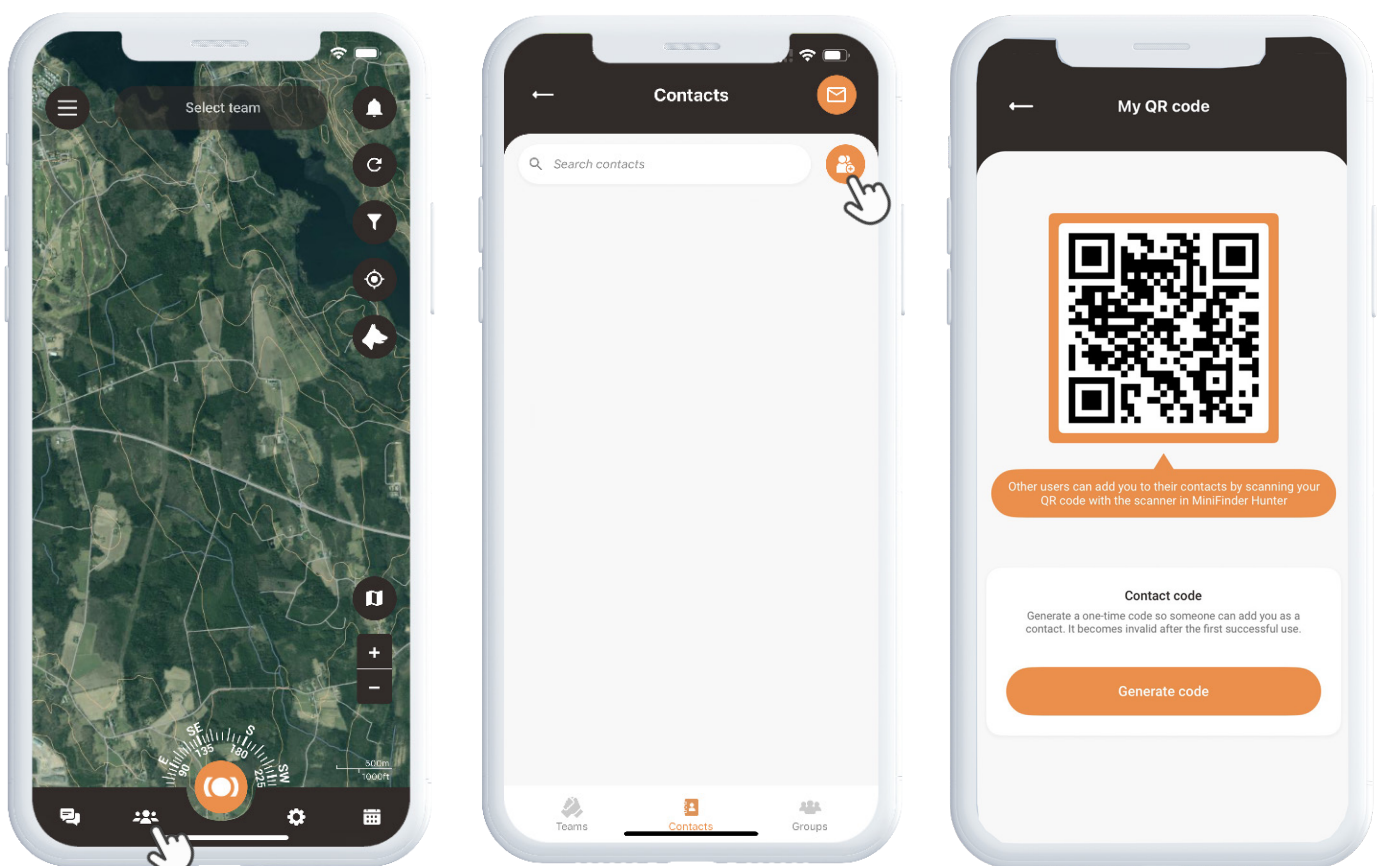
The panel can be moved up or down depending on how much information you want to display while keeping the map visible. Further down, you will also find View Profile and Settings, where you can access additional information about your dog and view previous location history.



Add Contacts

To add contacts, go to the team icon located in the app's footer. Look for the Contacts icon and select it. This section is in the center of the panel and gives you access to your contact list. To add a new contact, click the plus sign next to the search function.

1. Import existing contacts from your phone to MiniFinder Hunter.
2. If you have the person's email address, enter it in the designated field.
3. If the person is nearby, you can scan the QR code found in their profile. The QR code must be scanned using the camera function directly in the MiniFinder Hunter app.

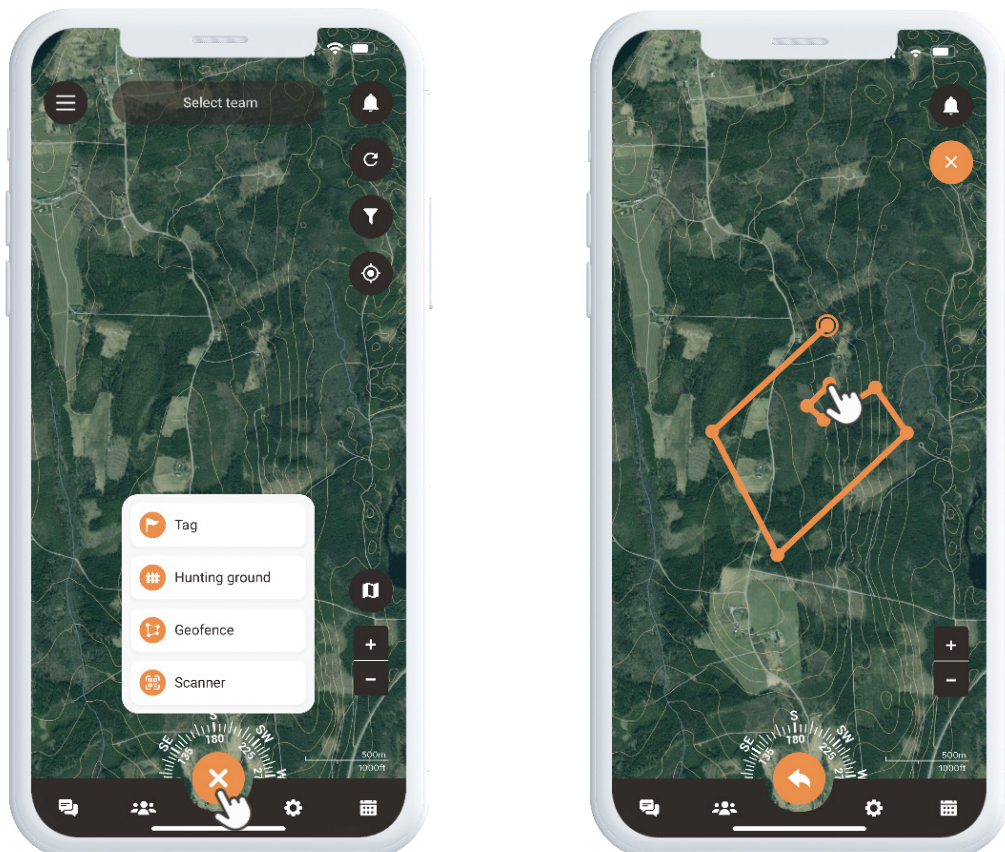


Hunting Grounds

To create a hunting ground, open Hunting Ground from the quick menu. Mark the area you want to use as your hunting ground by placing points on the map and connecting them.

Give your hunting ground a name and select a color before saving. Once the hunting ground has been created, you can easily adjust its boundaries afterwards. Press and hold a point on the boundary, then drag it to a new position on the map. This allows you to change the shape of the hunting ground without having to redraw the entire area.

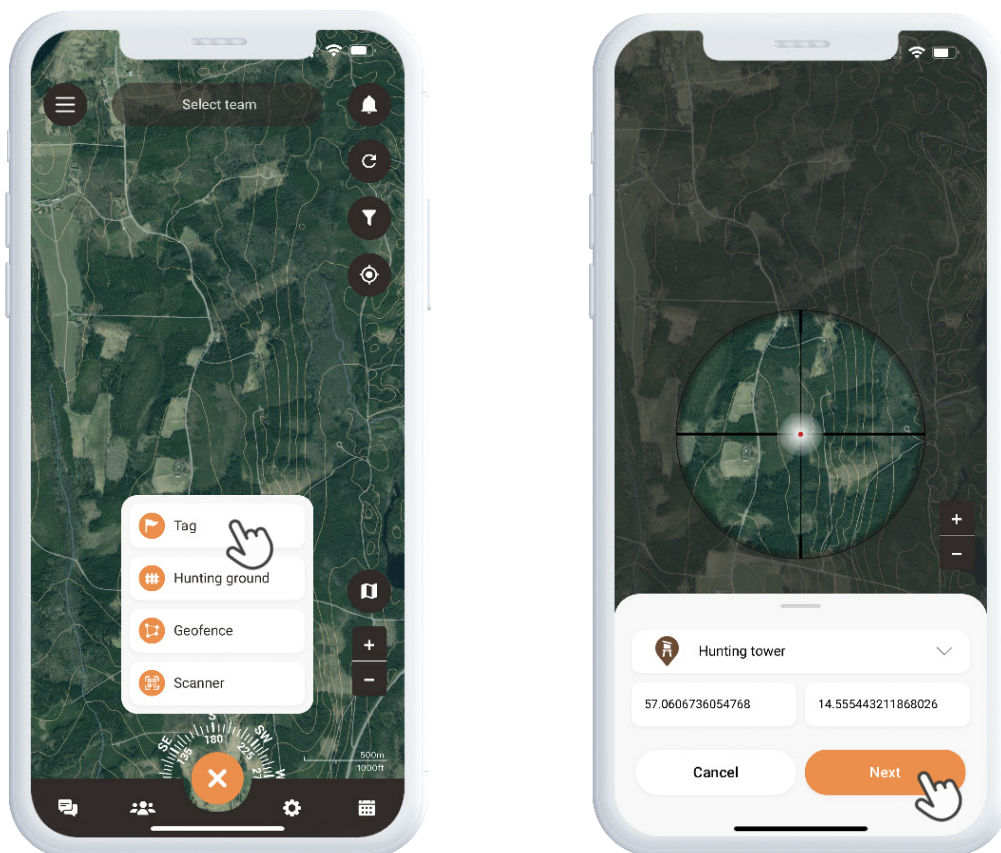
Once you have created a hunting ground, you can continue by creating a team. To invite other users, you can use the QR code or enter a user code, which can be generated in the same place as the QR code.



Tags

To access the Tag feature, click on the quick menu and select Tag. Move the crosshair to the location where you want to place the tag. You will be introduced to various tags to choose from.

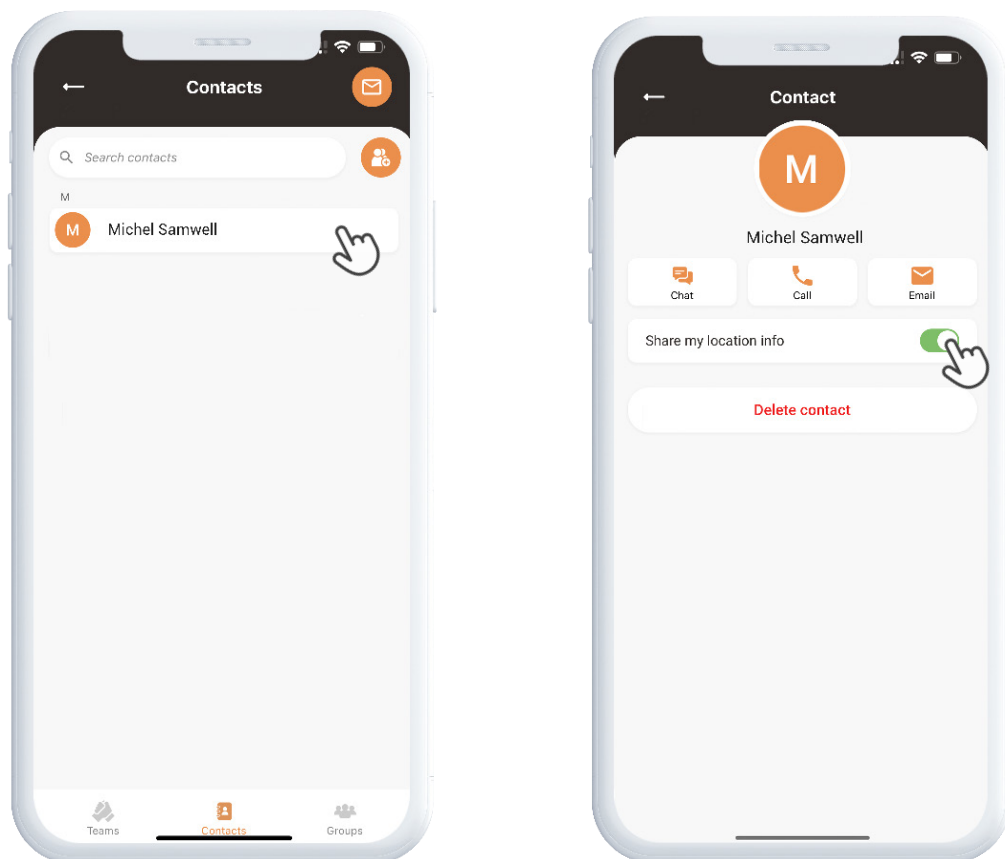
Once you've selected the tag you want to place on the map, add a tag label and additional details about the tag if desired. Click Save, and the tag will appear on the map.



Share your Position

To share your own location, open your contact list again. Find the person you wish to share your location with and tap on their name to open their profile.

Then, activate 'Share my location info'.

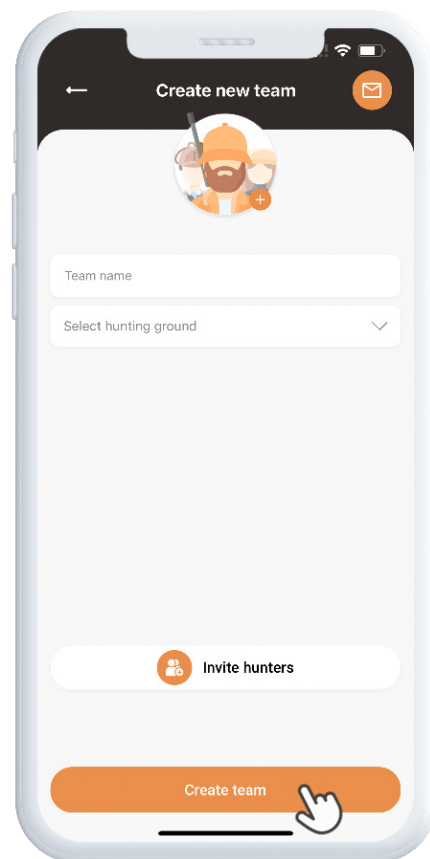
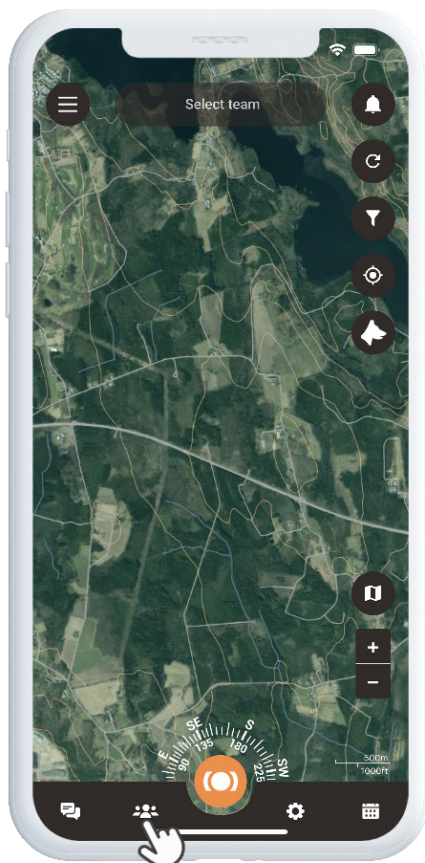


Hunting Team

To create a new team, go to the Team icon in the footer of the app and tap Create New Team. Enter a team name and then add the hunting ground the team will use. You can create a new hunting ground, select an existing one or import a hunting ground.

Once the team has been created, you can invite team members and start planning upcoming hunts.

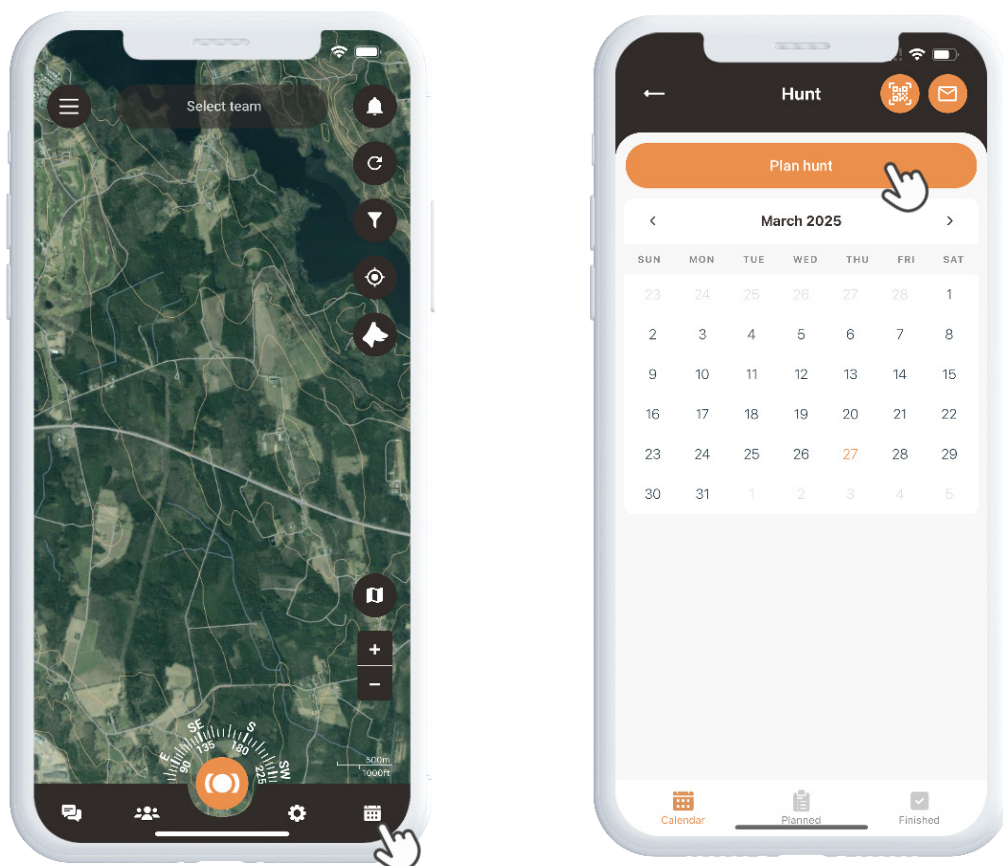
If you are a member of several teams, you can easily select the team you want to focus on for the upcoming hunt. When you select a team, you will be taken directly to the selected hunting ground on the map.



Plan Hunt

To create a hunting event, click on the calendar icon in the footer and select "Plan hunt."
Here, you can choose the hunting area, start and end dates, and a description of the event.

Invitations will be sent to the selected hunters, and the event will automatically appear in the calendar.
You will receive notifications when the invited hunters accept or decline your invitation.
